Now is a good time to review the 2010 housing or parsonage allowances designated for all credentialed ministers on staff. If an allowance designated for 2010 is clearly below actual housing expenses, then the church board should consider declaring a larger portion of the credentialed minister's remaining compensation as a housing or parsonage allowance. A church is free to designate any portion of a credentialed minister's compensation as a housing allowance, but remember that clergy who own their homes may never claim a housing allowance exclusion greater than the fair rental value of the home (furnished, including utilities). Therefore, the allowance ordinarily should not be significantly more than this amount.
