## **Explorer Territory 2007 Rendezvous**

### **Read this page carefully for important stuff**

**Camp setup** is allowed on Wednesday only except by special permission of the FCF Territorial Rep. This is due to the fact there is a Kids Camp at the site the same week and access is controlled. Wednesday setup will allow Thursday to be a full day of Rendezvous. We want to emphasize primitive frontier camping. No visible plastics/modern stuff. Hide your coolers and things or cover them with hides or blankets.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTE ON THIS SITE FOR THIS RENDEZVOUS**

**There is a Kids Camp in progress this week until noon Friday. You are asked that upon arrival, to drive through the developed campground on the road, directly to the Rendezvous site. There is no need to ask where the rendezvous site is – keep driving on the camp road; you will know when you are in the right place.**

**PLEASE BE CAREFULL, there may be children running about. The campground is large but the only access is through the camp. We have been asked to limit trips in and out until Friday noon, when the youth campers will be gone.**

**Our Rendezvous Speaker is a favorite among us – Sonny Green.  
Sonny is former national vice president and currently FCF Emeritus**

**Trader's Row** - Those interested in setting up a tent on trader's row, be sure to send your Trader's Row application to Wayne Farrand by July 1. A respectable auction item is the fee. Remember, there are likely many new members with an interest in basic FCF paraphernalia. Also, the young bucks just getting started come expecting. Old timers like quality things, too.

**SCOUT SELECTIONS** - National and Territorial scouts will be selected. Each Chapter is responsible to submit the applications for their Chapter's Scout and Assistant Scout by July 1. Use the Scout Nominating Form in the current Officer's Notebook. Include a picture. Selection will use the new vote and skills process.

**PRIZES – THERE WILL BE DRAWINGS FOR TWO BIG PRIZES.** One for a Young Buck and one for an Old Timer. They will be very respectable prizes Young bucks who wish to enter must bring an authorization signed by a parent or guardian and a commander from his outpost or chapter FCF officer

Chapters should arrange to have judges at event sites on **Thursday afternoon and Friday morning and afternoon**. The **Seneca run and Young Buck Event** will be on Saturday (Suppose Sage will be there again?). Chapters should plan their event and make it exciting and authentic. Prizes will be medallions. Horseshoes will be young buck/old timer teams. Some events may have some new variations but will involve the basic frontier skills.

**Other Events** - There will be other contests, planned and spontaneous: such as cooking and **special shoots**. Chapters can sponsor **special events or make challenges**. Just clear it through the Territorial Rep. on site. There'll be plenty of chances to show off shooting skills. Bring plenty of lead and powder.

**Marbles** - Everyone will be issued marbles to compete in authentic pioneer marble games (instructions provided or make up your own).

**Best Primitive lodge/campsite** – Show your stuff, win the prize. We're looking for authenticity. This will be a lodge by lodge evaluation. Period correct is what it takes.

**Cookin' contest** – We'll all eat together Friday evening but there will be a table for the real competitive cooks where the taster judges will partake before everyone else. Cook up what yer proud of!

**MISSION AUCTION** - Everyone is encouraged to **bring items** for the FCF mission fundraiser auction. We'll have a special project identified for this benefit.

**Music** - Chapters with musicians (singers or instrumental) please note on the registration form or contact The Territorial Rep. **Bring your musical instruments**. Musicians will lead the worship each evening.

**Blacksmithing** – Plans are to have a supervised forge area to give young bucks and old timers a chance to see and do some iron work. Any smithys who want to bring a portable forge and blacksmith coal, you are welcome to demonstrate your trade and teach a young buck.

## **SPECIAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE RENDEZVOUS SITE**

**We want everyone to be safe and come prepared. The Rendezvous site is on the grounds of Iowa's A/G District Camp. This is a developed camp but our site is in the primitive area. Porta Johns are provided. Showers will be not be available until noon on Friday.**

**The site is in central Iowa, not more than a long day's drive for anyone in our territory. Take the challenge of RENDEZVOUS 2007**

**Use the attached map from Boone and Ogden, Iowa if you are unfamiliar with the area. Boone is West of the City of Ames which is on Interstate 35. It is accessible by car, horse or canoe (takes a little longer), so plan your route.**

**Family and friends can tent or RV camp at the camp for a fee. There are water, sewer and electrical hookups near the rendezvous site. Because the RV sites are near Rendezvous, visiting hours must be enforced. Visitation to the rendezvous area will be only during visiting hours. FCF members should plan on staying in the FCF rendezvous area except for special circumstances.**

**Firewood will be made available courtesy of the Iowa Royal Rangers at designated sites. Some cutting may be necessary. Charcoal or camp stoves may be a useful contingency. If it is a dry summer, open fire bans are possible. There is good water on site. We hope to have ice available for purchase to avoid trips to town.**

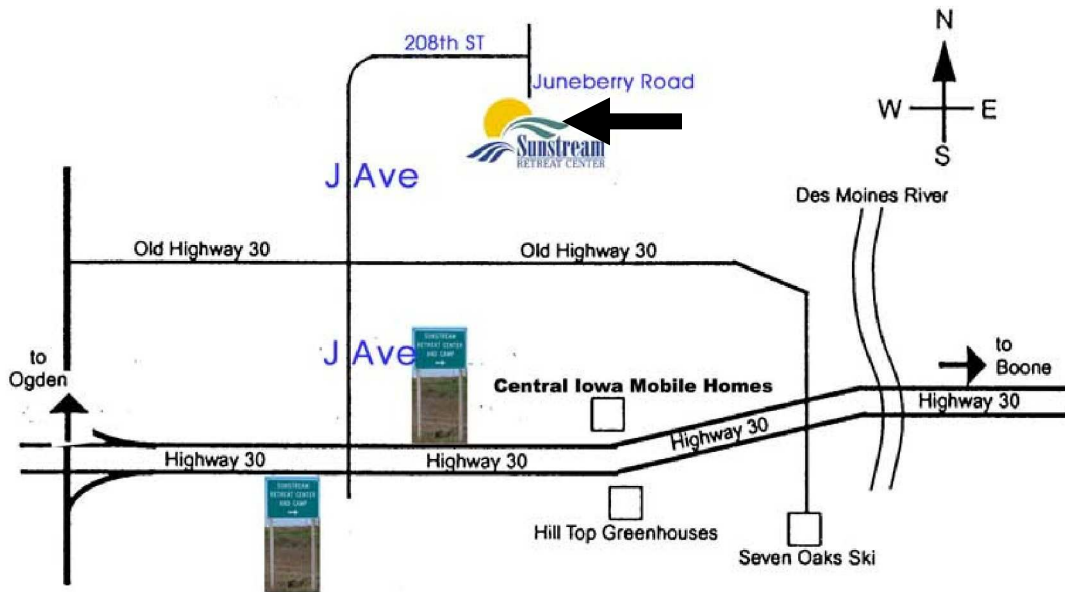
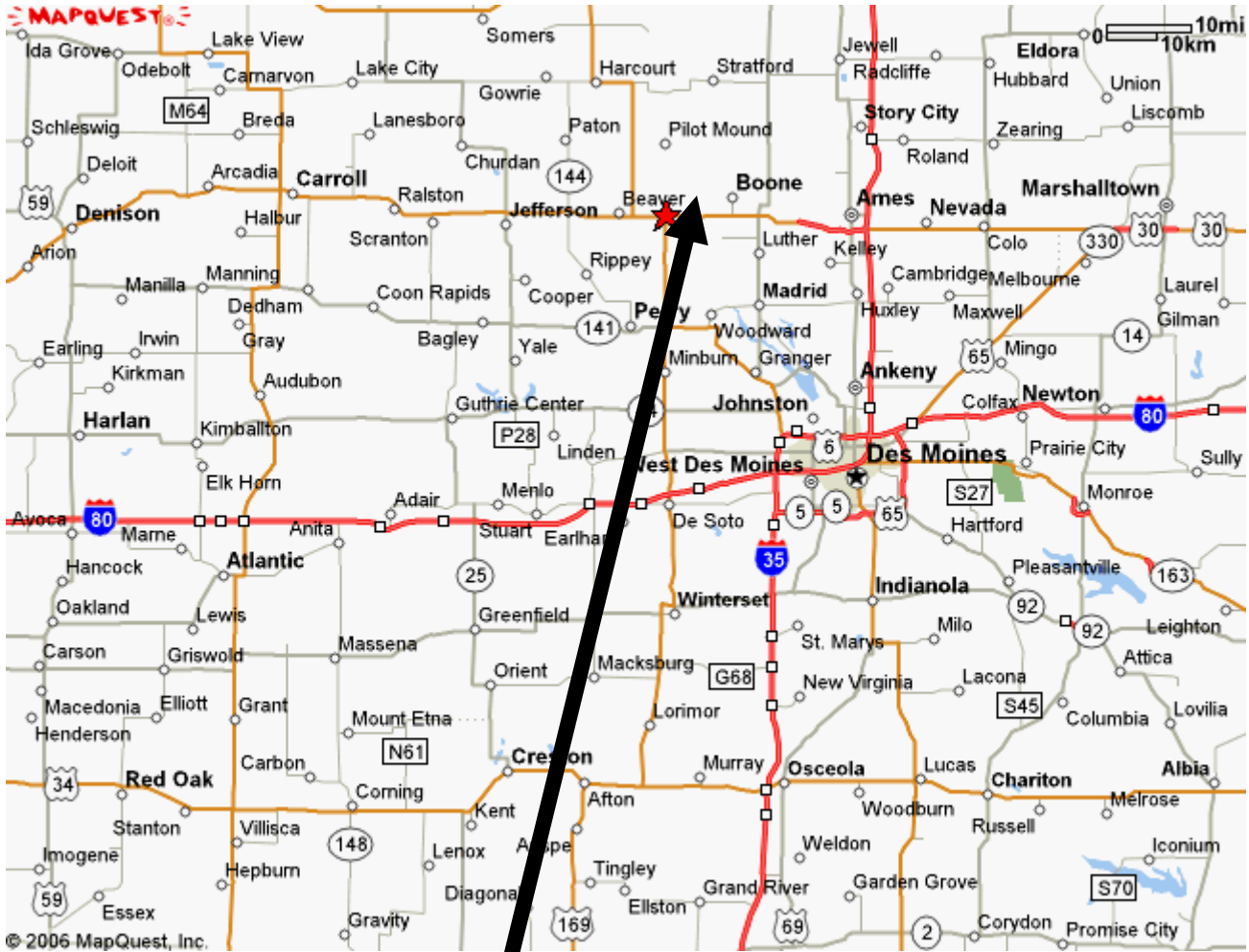
